Literacy

- Writing more complex sentences using a wider range of conjunctions to extend writing
- Using simple punctuation accurately with increasing independence (Aa . ! ?)
- Begin to use commas correctly in list writing
- Writing for a range of purposes e.g. descriptive writing, story language, non-fiction
- Proof -reading writing to make necessary changes and adjustments for sense
- Looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts

Maths

- Recognising equal and unequal groups
- Making equal groups for sharing and grouping
- Finding a double of a number
- Introduction to multiplication - 2s, 5s and 10s
- Dividing by 2, 5 and 10
- Recognising and using tally charts and pictograms

Phonics

- Continue to re-cap phase 5 sounds (particularly split digraphs) whilst applying our knowledge of phase 3 and 4 sounds
- Grow in confidence when reading and writing common exception words
- Explore a range of Phase 6 suffixes and learn these spelling rules

Topic

- Our new Topic is 'Material World' where we will be learning to recognise and use a range of different materials
- Exploring how and why we would use a material for a specific purpose
- Using a range of materials and mediums to create artwork
- Learning about seasonal weather patterns and differences in climate around the World

RE, PSHE & PE

- PSHE - Understanding what an opinion is, being able to express an opinion and listen to the opinions of others on a variety of topics
- RE - Learning about a variety of special and holy books within different religions
- PE - Thinking about rhythm and matching beats with movements

Other
