9 <sup>th</sup> November 2016	Governors had impacted on the education of the children by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appointing a Co-Opted governor with skills that would be beneficial to the GB</li><li>• Reviewing their own structures, processes and practices to ensure they were statutorily compliant, efficient and remained fit for purpose</li><li>• Reviewing the School Improvement Priorities and ensuring that the school and GB focused on key issues</li><li>• Considering their safeguarding responsibilities and ensuring they remained up-to-date.</li></ul>
15 <sup>th</sup> March 2017	Governors had: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Considered the implications of budget cuts and agreed that the primary focus was to maintain small teaching groups</li><li>• Nursery and After-School Provision had been reviewed in light of funding reductions and alternative options were being considered</li><li>• Been pro-active with regard to their own training and development, ensuring that they had the skills and knowledge required to fulfil their duties.</li></ul>
24 <sup>th</sup> May 2017 (budget focus)	Governors had agreed a balanced budget, which focused on the school's strategic priorities.
28 <sup>th</sup> June 2017	This meeting was cancelled as a result of the Grenfell tragedy and the impact it had on the school and community.
