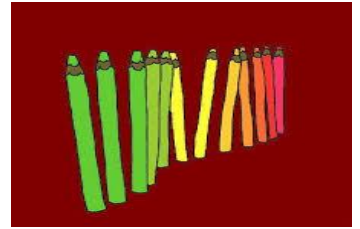


Year Three Open Morning Feedback
