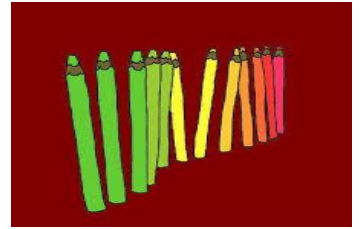


Nursery Open Morning Feedback

What we aim to do as a result of your suggestions...

1. While in the Nursery we aim to improve the children's motor skills so that they are able to hold a pencil correctly and begin to form recognisable letters. Regular activities such as manipulating playdough or threading beads should develop the muscles in the children's fingers. As the year continues you should see an improvement in your child's ability to write their own name.
2. During this year the children will be spending lots of time developing their early reading, writing and maths and the children have daily carpet sessions designed to develop these skills. They also regularly look through books, develop their ability to count and recognise numbers and explore mark making in a range of different ways. All of these skills are essential first steps in reading, writing and maths and we aim for them to be embedded by the end of the year.
