22 <sup>nd</sup> May 2018	<p>Governors had:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Considered the budget in detail and set a balanced budget. They ensured the school's priorities were adequately resourced and that the school's continued primary focus on small teaching groups could be maintained.</li><li>• Continued to strategically consider issues that were specific to the school, its community and its future i.e. regeneration of the school and support for families affected by Grenfell.</li><li>• Completed a schedule of visits in order to extend their knowledge and this would feed into the school's strategic documents, e.g SEF and SIP</li><li>• Monitored the introduction of the school's GDPR compliance under new regulations.</li></ul>
